### Centres for Innovation in Regional Health

Efforts are well underway for Tasmania to submit to the NHMRC's Centres for Innovation in Regional Health program during the next call for submission (expected in late 2018). The program was established in 2016 to specifically recognise centres that address regional Australia population needs. NHMRC recognition is valid for five years for successful programs. NHMRC states that CIRH initiatives core aim is to "encourage excellent health research and translation in Australia by bringing together researchers, healthcare providers, education and training to improve the health and well-being of patients and the populations they serve, including in regional/remote areas for CIRHs."
